Food Bank Sorting	Volunteers inspect incoming food for quality assurance and prepare for distribution by bagging produce and bulk items. Bread and pastries also get sorted after being inspected. Food Bank Distribution Home Delivery Packing and Preparation Client Services	Volunteers will work directly with neighbors to pack foods to last the family for an entire week. Volunteers pack boxes for homebound clients following specific restrictions. The later shift will have an emphasis on organizing packed boxes to be picked up by drivers. Volunteers are needed to welcome all of our neighbors and assist them through the registration or check-in process. Volunteers in this role will be trained to use our database and require a longer time commitment.	You will serve with 18-20 volunteers. Level of physical activity varies depending on position. You will work with 8-9 volunteers. This opportunity requires standing for the duration of the shift as well as bending and lifting of 30 lbs. You can expect to work with one to two other volunteers. This position will require some standing and frequent bending.
